Nearly hundred tribal farmers of Muradpur, Nissanghat, Surabardi, Kawadapur and Khursapar of Umred Block, Nagpur district participated in the day long training at Muradpur, Bela. Dr. Blaise, Head, Division of Crop Production, delivered the inaugural address on improving cotton productivity by recycling farm waste and high density planting systems. Dr. V.
